Ms. DiGuiseppe came to join her fellow teachers and offer some positive publicity about Graystone, due to their upcoming Charter renewal and some of the negative publicity they have been receiving. She's been teaching 5th grade for 5 years and she has had nothing but positive experiences with the school, the parents and her students. She believes Graystone has touched and changed the lives of many of her students.
- 6) *Janice Lutz - Teacher @ Graystone Charter School:*
Ms. Lutz has been teacher at Graystone for 9 years. She has received offers to teach at other places, work shorter hours, and make more money but she hasn't accepted any interviews. Being at Graystone means a lot to her and her colleagues, and they and they are here tonight to support their Charter renewal.
