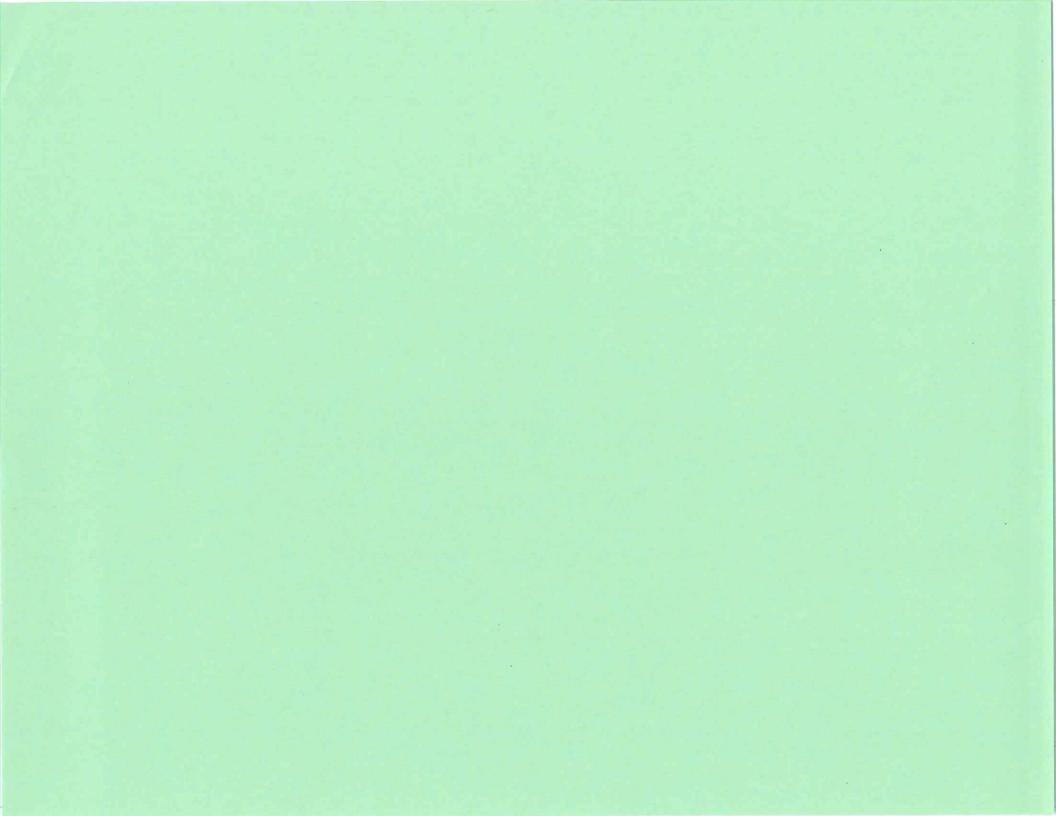

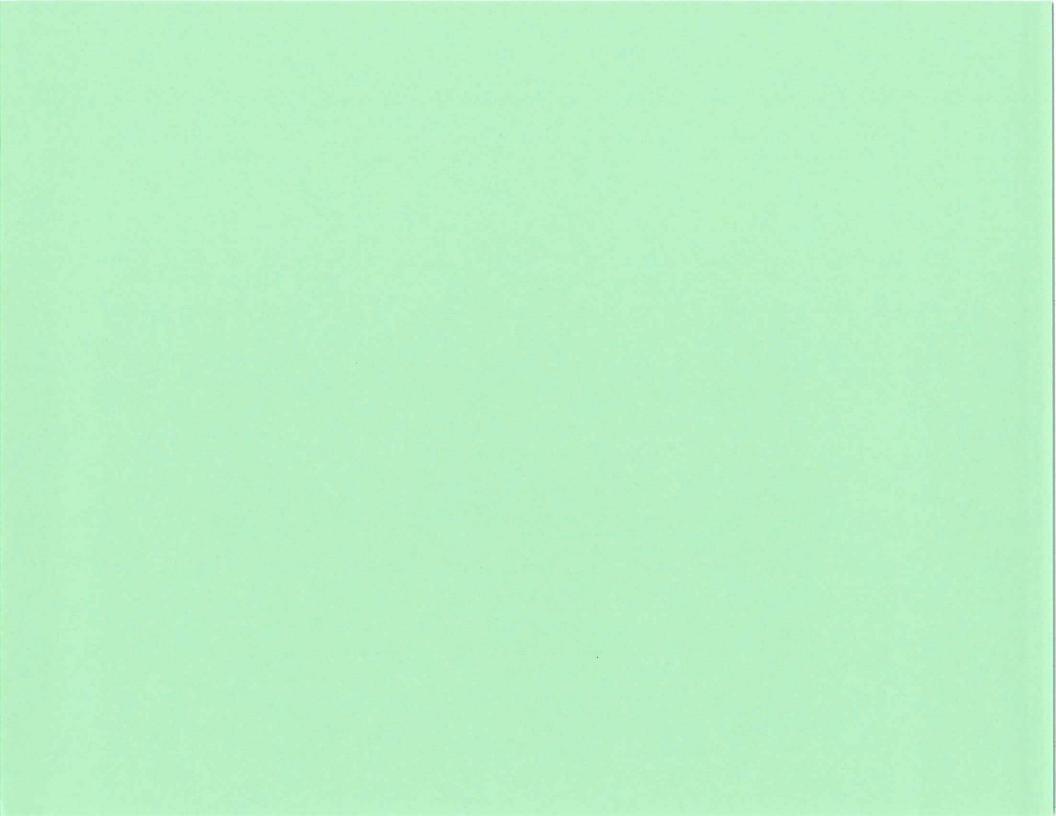

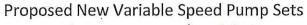

Current Situation:

- The existing pumping system is over 65 years old. (1957)
- The water tanks and piping has had continual issues with leaks and deterioration.
- The existing system uses air compressors (not oil less) to pressurize the water in the tanks. (Not recommended for drinking water)
- The storage tanks are severely rusted and most likely are effecting the quality of the drinking water.
- The existing pumping system does not take advantage of new technology variable speed drives on the motors to save energy.

Proposed Solution:

- Replace the existing pumping system with a new technology variable speed pumping system.
- Abandon the existing leaking storage tanks in the crawl space area.

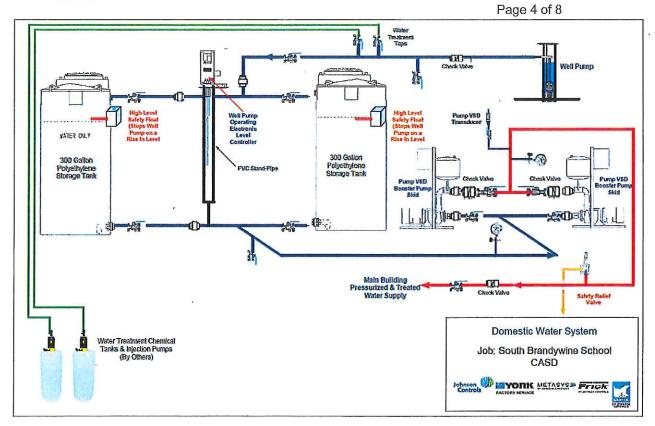

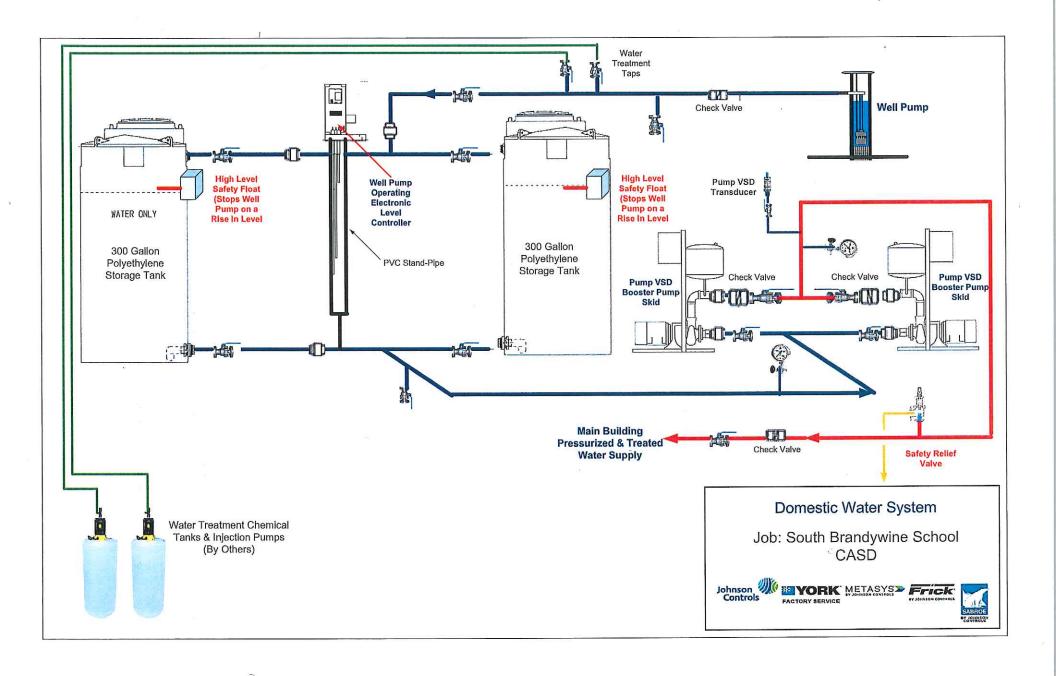

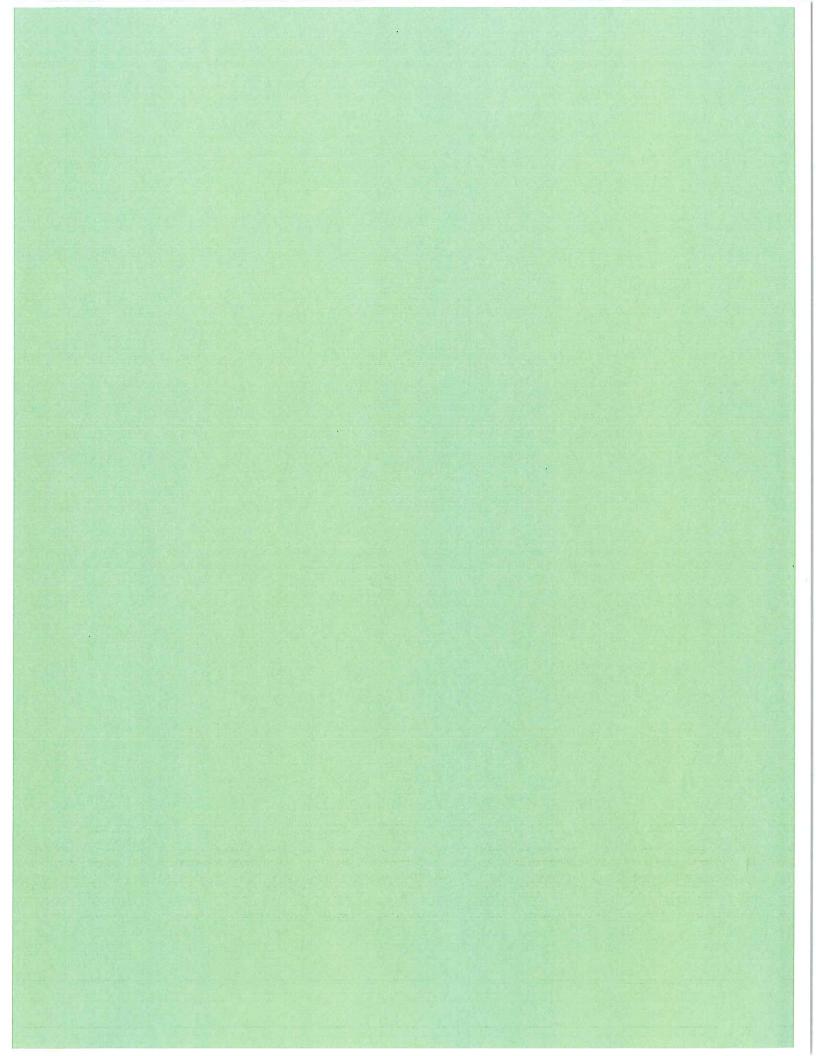
